
Library marketer of the year

Caru is a committed member of the Cultural Services Promotion's Team and is the lead for the Cultural Services Newsletter that is sent electronically to the whole Leisure Division of Carmarthenshire County Council. Caru collates all the information for this newsletter and again will give time outside of her working day to ensure that deadlines are met and everyone has information on what is going on within the Archives, Arts, Museums, Theatres and Libraries within Carmarthenshire. Caru mainly works in the Reference Department and is very interested in local history and in particular the history of Llanelli Library. Caru and the Reference Department Team have made contacts with various local historians and historical societies and she along with her colleagues has presented a very interesting presentation on the refurbishment and history of Llanelli Library and its holdings of over 7,000 local photographs. Most of these meetings and presentations are held outside of her working hours and Caru quite often will happily go straight from work to the meetings and not arrive home until ten o'clock that evening!

Carmarthenshire Libraries have recently submitted an application for funding from HLF for a local digitisation project which will bring together Library, Archive and Museum collections and focus on developing heritage and digital skills throughout Carmarthenshire to form a collaborative solution.

This will be done by creating a bilingual website as a global platform for our collections online, opening them up to new and wider audiences. The site will provide accessible, relevant and sustainable information sources and services that could otherwise be lost whilst promoting Carmarthenshire's heritage. With an emphasis on community participation, the digitisation project will also create opportunities for engagement, training, volunteering and employment. The aim is to preserve existing local heritage and encourage new contributions, increasing interest and enthusiasm in the sector. We will work with partner organisations such as Communities 2.0, Communities First and People's Collection Wales to provide best value and to further this aim. Caru is a vital member of this team and again has gone over and above the call of duty to ensure that Carmarthenshire Libraries has the best possible chance of achieving funding.

Therefore, I can only conclude that Caru James is a very worthy nominee for the Library Marketer of the year and would be delighted if you would consider this very positive, innovative and highly motivated young library assistant.
