



Mainstreaming Digital Inclusion across Libraries









Recommendations from DCW for the successful mainstreaming and implementation of Digital Inclusion across the library service are:

Undertake an approach to conducting a Digital Skills Audit to understand the baseline digital skills and confidence of Library colleagues

DCW can provide a bilingual template Digital Skills Audit that has been created in to understand Skills, confidence and access of staff and volunteers This should be carried on an annual basis to understand the skills or needs of staff and volunteers in the library service.

Culture division and Local Authority libraires to sign DCW's Digital Inclusion Charter and work towards Accreditation status

The Charter includes six pledges and is a way for organisations to show their commitment to promoting basic digital skills and helping digitally excluded people enjoy the benefits of being online. When an organisation signs the Digital Inclusion Charter, DCW are asking them to commit to the six key pledges – allowing us to work together in the spirit of co-operation to promote digital inclusion in Wales.
